## **CONSTRUCTION DO'S AND DO NOT'S!!**

## DO,

- Install Gator Joist right side up. Each Gator Joist is tagged showing "TOP".
- Use 2" x 6" strong back stiffeners as marked on each Gator Joist.
  Proper use of strong backs add additional resistance for impact loading of the floor system.
- Provide appropriate bearing width (minimum 1 1/2") at each end of the Gator Joist bottom flange.
- Use A.P.A. appropriately rated plywood subfloor material that has been both glued and screwed to the top flange of the Gator Joist.
- Contact distributor about special loadings, bearing conditions or construction details not covered in the **Gator Joist** Installation Guide.

## <u>DO NOT!</u>

- Install Gator Joist upside down.
- Cut any part of the Gator Joist except for the trimmable section, which is designed to be field trimmed to length (12" maximum of each end).
   Joist trims do not have to be symmetrical.
- Remove, cut, or loosen any metal connector plate on the Gator Joist.
- Use a Gator Joist as a header or beam.
- Allow a Gator Joist to be supported by the top flange
- Rafter cut or bevel cut the trimmable section without first consulting your
